Burton, Brian K. *The Peninsula & Seven Days: A Battlefield Guide*. Lincoln, NE: University of Nebraska Press, 2007. Not just a guidebook to the numerous sites involved in the campaign, this study includes description and analysis of local actions and vignettes about units and individuals.

Cullen, Joseph P. *The Peninsula Campaign: McClellan & Lee Struggle for Richmond*. New York: Bonanza Books, 1973. Dated, but still a good survey of the campaign.

Dowdley, Clifford. *The Seven Days: The Emergence of Lee*. New York: Fairfax Press, 1964.

One of the first modern studies of the campaign, this book perhaps spends too much time on Lee's background beforehand.

Freeman, Douglas S. *Lee's Lieutenants, Vol. I: Manassas to Malvern Hill*. New York: Charles Scribner's Sons, 1942. Still an excellent study on the personalities of the various Confederate generals and how Lee tried to get them to work together.

Gallagher, Gary W. (Editor). *The Richmond Campaign of 1862: The Peninsula & Seven Days*. Chapel Hill: University of North Carolina Press, 2008. Nine essays by several authors on various topics relating to the campaign.

Johnson, Robert U. and Clarence C. Buel. *Battles and Leaders of the Civil War*. New York: The Century Company, 1887 (later reprints available). 4 Volumes. Excellent accounts of the major actions by some of the leading participants on both sides, written in the 1880s. The Peninsula Campaign is covered in Volume 2.

Miller, William J. (Editor). *The Peninsula Campaign: Yorktown to the Seven Days*. Campbell, CA: Savas Woodbury, 1995, 1997. 3 Volumes. Contains eighteen monographs by different authors on individual units and officers and other various aspects of the campaign.

Sears, Stephen. *The Civil War Papers of George B. McClellan: Selected Correspondence, 1860-1865*. New York: Ticknor & Fields, 1989. McClellan's frequent letters to his wife reveal what he was really thinking during the campaign.

War of the Rebellion: A Compilation of the Official Records of the Union and Confederate Armies. Washington, DC: US Government Printing Office, 1880-1901. 128 volumes.

Contains battle reports from regimental officers to army commanders, as well as orders of battle, tables of losses, and records of correspondence on both sides. Material on the Peninsula Campaign is located in Series I, Volume II (3 Parts).

Webb, Alexander S. *The Peninsula*. New York: Charles Scribner's Sons, 1881 (later reprints available). An objective account of the campaign by an officer who participated in it. Webb does not hesitate to criticize both McClellan and Lincoln for their mistakes.

Wheeler, Richard. *Sword Over Richmond: An Eyewitness History of McClellan's Peninsula Campaign*. New York: Harper & Row, 1986. An account of the campaign using extensive quotations by participants ranging from privates to generals.

Note: There are unfortunately no monographs on the individual engagements of the Seven Days Battles. There are a number of good biographies on the leading Confederate participants in the campaign (A.P. Hill, D.H. Hill, Huger, Jackson, Lee, Longstreet, Magruder, Stuart) but little of significance has been written on the key Union commanders other than McClellan.


